

3-hour Music & Worship Arts Ministry Internship

Duluth First United Methodist is located approximately 25 miles northeast of Emory University, along the I-85 corridor. With an average Sunday attendance of 1000, Duluth First offers numerous music and worship arts opportunities. Each Sunday morning we worship in the sanctuary at 9:30 and 11:00 in a very traditional style. Music is led by various choirs, with hymns and other congregational songs accompanied by organ, piano, and occasionally handbells and orchestra. We also offer a more contemporary style of worship at 9:30 in our Grand Hall, led by a small group of musicians. Once a month, from August-April, we also offer an Evening Prayer or *Vespers* service.

The goal of this internship is to provide a well-rounded experience in music & worship arts ministry. The **music ministry intern** will meet weekly with the Minister of Music & Worship Arts to discuss relative topics in the various areas of music ministry, to set goals and evaluate progress, and to plan for the coming week. Opportunities will include, but are not limited to:

- Assistance with and/or participation in the various choirs and ensembles
(Chancel Choir, Chamber Ensemble, Men's Ensemble, Women's Ensemble, youth choir, children's choirs, handbell ensemble)
- Worship planning for traditional, contemporary, and vespers services
- Data entry/filing in the choral library
- Correspondence with members of the music ministry
- Management of the *DFUMC Music & Worship Arts* Facebook page
- Set-ups for rehearsals and various music & worship arts events
- Artist booking and correspondence, program creation, etc. for Music & Fine Arts Series
