St. Luke is a small United Methodist Church located in the heart of the Harrisburg Community in Augusta, Georgia. Harrisburg, a former Mill Village, began losing its identity as a solid blue collar community when the mills closed 20 plus years ago. 75 % of the property in Harrisburg is now rental and 97% of the students who attend the neighborhood elementary school receive free lunches. St. Luke UMC has served our neighborhood for 145+ years. Eight years ago we made the decision to open our doors and invite our neighbors to join us. Because of that decision we have grown into a congregation that truly reflects our neighborhood. We are black, white, rich, poor, young, old and everything in between. Our strength is our diversity.

Two Non-profits have grown out of St. Luke. Harrisburg Family Health Care, a Primary Health Care Clinic opened 30 hours a week and Good Neighbor Ministries, which exists to serve our community in a variety of ways. Most recently, we were chosen by Wholesome Wave to be the Pilot Program location for their Fruit & Veggie Rx Program for the state of Georgia. We are a small, financially strapped congregation with a very large footprint in a struggling community and we are looking for men and women who are called to ministries of service in transitional communities like ours. We can offer housing, free medical care and a small stipend.
