| ES 679 1 (concurrent listing from Emory Law) | Special Topics in Law and Religion: Law and Religion in Practice (ON CAMPUS) (Prerequisite: First Amendment Religious Freedom course (ES 684 or LAW equivalent) OR instructor permission) (The topic of law and religion often brings to mind the First Amendment, full stop. While constitutional law no doubt plays a critical role in how issues involving religion are adjudicated in the United States today, there are a number of other areas in which religion shows up in legal practice. Building upon a constitutional law foundation, the course will explore the ways in which employment, education (Title IX), property and zoning, tax, arbitration, criminal (hate crimes), and immigration law encounter religion. The course will also examine religion as it appears in different types of legal practice, including litigation, arbitration, and policymaking. The course will pay particular attention to how religion, religious practice, and religious people are constructed in/by law. | ES 679 2 (concurrent listing from Emory Law) | Special Topics in Law and Religion: History of Religious Freedom (ON CAMPUS) (This course will explore the history of religious freedom and church-state relations in the Western legal tradition, with a strong focus on the foundations of American religious freedom. We will analyze the variety of constitutional and other legal arrangements developed to facilitate the separation, cooperation, and mutual protection of churches and states. We will trace the gradual development of religious rights and liberties for individuals and groups in Europe, but also the systematic and oft-brutal denial of these rights to religious, cultural, and racial minorities on both sides of the Atlantic. And we will study the gradual rise of constitutional principles of religious liberty in the American colonies culminating in the founding era constitutions -- especially the First Amendment with its twin commands to disestablish religion and to protect the free exercise rights of all. Readings will include primary and secondary sources, calibrated for the uninitiated but interested reader. Classes will consist of lecture and discussion, with students rewarded for regular classroom participation.
